Consequences of Cyberbullying

- Do not give out your personal information like email, address and phone number to any sites

- Change your password regularly

- Have private accounts on social media and don't except any friend requests of people who you don't know personally, have posted inappropriate content or make you feel uncomfortable

- Do not post any content related to other users

- Don't respond to any messages which contain threats and harassment or negative comments

What can you do to stay safer on the internet and prevent cyberbullying from happening

- keep track of the times and dates you get bad messages or emails it might be helpful later on
- If you see cyberbullying going on report it!
- If you are experiencing cyberbullying, tell somebody, get help, talk to a parent or an aunt
