The Pomeranian

The Pomeranian (often known as a Pom or Pom Pom) is a breed of dog of the Spitz type, named for the Pomerania region in Central Europe. Classed as a toy dog breed because of its small size, the Pomeranian is descended from the larger Spitz type dogs, specifically the German Spitz. In many countries, they are known as the Zwergspitz (Dwarf Spitz).



It is physical reaches 40 inches and weighs 19 kg for variant giant; can measure already the standard 36 cm and up to 12 kg, while the toy weighs more than 10 kg and measures 28 cm. The breed is currently among the top 15 most popular in the USA, and the current fashion for small dogs has increased their popularity worldwide.



The origin of the English Bulldog is quite remote and its name derives from the fact that until the mid eighteenth century the breed was used in the fighting with bulls (bull BAITINGS). At that time, Bulldogues were somewhat different from the current standard, more like the boxer (taller, muscular and agile, with long limbs and straighter). Its most striking feature, the jaw became more developed than the upper jaw so he could bite, bottom-up.



If its origin in the Bulldog was considered a "vicious dog" and used in combat, now this is just legend. Even with its wild expression, the bulldog is an excellent companion dog, very docile and affectionate.

Despite the physical size solid and heavy, the Bulldog can be a playful companion and full of energy. It's a dog "good peace", which relates very well with children as long as they respect your boundaries for play and even with other dogs provided there are no "brutality" in living
