The "discoverer" of the breed was the Norwegian Nansen Fridjof that in 1870 he was impressed with the strength and versatility of the Samoyed and used as a draft dog in their holdings. Many other explorers also used dogs Samoyeds on his travels to the poles these dogs were brought from Siberia, which made possible the conquest of the poles by explorers like Roald Amundsen and American Robert Peary. The first men to set foot at the South Pole and the North Pole respectively. The first copies were imported into Europe in 1889, were brought to Britain by British zoologist Ernest Kilburn Scott who, after living among the tribe of Samoyeds for three months returned home carrying a male puppy named "Sabarka" later he imported more copies, a female named "Whitey Petchora" and another male named "Musti".
