

The German spitz (in English: Kleinspitz) is a breed that originated in Germany has three distinct varieties of size: the giant and miniature ostandard, popularly known as lulu-of-Pomerania. Historically, these animals came to Europe taken by the Vikings, being first mentioned in German literature in 1450.

While the midsize cainino was created for grazing, the other two are designed to be companion dogs. Why not like to be commanded, must be trained from an early age. They are still classified as alerts and outgoing, stubborn though.

Its physical reaches 40 inches and weighs 19 kg for variant giant; can measure already the standard 36 cm and up to 12 kg, while the toy weighs more than 10 kg and measures 28 cm. Labrador

The Labrador retriever is a dog whose weight varies from 35 to 43 kilos.

The height of Labrador is between 55 and 58 cm.

The most common colors are: yellow, black and chocolate brown.

Originally it was called the Labradors "small Newfoundlands" and both races have the particularity of having physical fingers connected by a membrane.

The first dog named "Labrador" appeared in 1839 and belonged to the Duke of Buccleuch designer, who contributed much to the present aspect of Labrador, through an intensive qualifying race. Nevertheless, in the middle of the last century, Labradors were still far from being a race by autonomous are all very different from each other. But there was one thing in common, all were from Newfoundland, the island north of the Gulf of St. Lourenço.

When the island was occupied by the British in the late sixteenth century, there were dogs that accompanied the fishermen in the boats, caught fish in the sea and pulling nets ashore. Were used two types of dogs: the first dogs were heavy, large, longhaired, who dragged their boats and nets ashore and pulling carts, and the latter were smaller and skilled, shorthaired, very dense and waterproof used almost exclusively for work in water.

The two species were essentially black in color and density due to his coat, showed no sensitivity to the icy waters of Newfoundland.



Dalmatas

The breed dogs weigh between 25 and 30 pounds.

Initially it was used to store stables and also to escort carriages are known by the name of "coach dogs" (dogs carriage).

The animals of this breed are strong, muscular and very active. It is dedicated to the owner, self-confident, gentle, loving, being considered a loyal breed. It is very popular around the world, and part of this fame is attributed to the design of Walt Disney's "101 Dalmatians," the year 1961.



Siberian husky

The Siberian Husky is a canine breed, medium size, originating from Siberia. It has primitive appearance, resembling a wolf. These animals are very light and move with grace. The males measure 53.5 cm to 60 cm and weigh between 20 kg to 28 kg; females measuring 50.5 cm to 56 cm and weighing between 15.5 to 20 kg.

They have heads of medium size and in proportion to body, slightly rounded at the top, tapering gradually, the stop is well defined, the nose is black in animals gray, brown or black; liver in copper dogs; may be reddish in all dogs white.

These animals are very independent, active, intelligent, friendly, kind and outgoing, and are not possessive or suspicious of strangers.
